I refer to the request which you made under the Freedom of Information Acts 1997 and 2003 for records held by this Body dated 30th November 2012.

I have made a final decision to part grant your request on Thursday 14th February 2013. If you have any queries regarding this correspondence you can contact me by telephone at (01) 8798360.

The purpose of this letter is to explain that decision. This explanation has the following parts:

1. schedules of the records covered by your request;
2. concerning records to which access is granted, an explanation and a statement of the arrangements for this access and its form;
3. details of your request, the relevant records and schedules and, concerning records to which access is denied, an explanation of the relevant findings; and
4. a statement of how you can appeal this decision should you wish to do so.

This letter addresses each of these four parts in turn.

1. Schedules of records

A series of schedules is attached at the end of this letter. It shows the documents that the Authority considers relevant to your request. The schedules describe each document, and indicate whether the document is released, released with deletions or not released. The schedule refers to the sections of the FOI Act which apply to prevent release. As to these documents, the schedules also provides brief reasons for the decision which are meant to supplement the fuller and more detailed explanation given under heading 3. below.

2. Access Arrangements

You have sought access to the records by means of photocopies, and I consider this an appropriate form of access in this case. Accordingly, the records described as released in full or released with deletion are now enclosed.

3. Findings, particulars and reasons for any decisions to deny access.

In this section I reproduce the items of your request and then describe what records are being released and any which aren't and the reasons for same. To help to understand how the records have been identified, I refer you to the schedules attached. Each schedule has been allocated a letter (Schedules A to G) and each record on the schedule then has an alpha-numeric identifier (which is copied onto the top right corner of each record), e.g. Schedule A refers to records related to changes to Bus Éireann fares increases correspondence in 2011, Schedule B to Bus Éireann fares correspondence in 2012, etc. and the records are recorded as B1, B2, B3, etc. with attachments as B.1.1., B1.2, etc. as the case may be. Where there has been a chain of e-mails rather than reproduce each individual e-mail I have released the last in the exchange (though some e-mails have been responded to by different personnel so there is some replication of material in the records released).

Abbreviations have been used in places as follows: BÁC means Bus Átha Cliath-Dublin Bus; BÉ means Bus Éireann; IÉ means Iarnród Éireann-Irish Rail and NTA means National Transport Authority.

The search for relevant documents included a search of the physical files held by the Authority, the electronic files held by the Authority, and a request issued to the relevant personnel of the Authority and interviews with same.

Your request had 2 items as follows:

- 1. The records that I am seeking is any corresponding letters, emails, faxes, memos etc and so on between your offices and Dublin Bus, Bus Éireann and Iarnród Éireann regarding fare increases between 1 January 2011 to date in 2012 (i.e. 30th November 2012).*

Records of correspondence between the Authority and the three operators, broken down by date, are listed in the Schedules as follows: Schedule A and B relate to Bus Éireann for 2011 and 2012, Schedules C and D to Dublin Bus for 2011 and 2012 and Schedules F and G to Iarnród Éireann for 2011 and 2012.

Sections 27(1)(b) and (c) of the FOI Acts (see extracts attached below) allow for the refusal of the release of a record if (b)"... its disclosure could reasonably be expected to result in a material financial loss or gain to the relevant person or if it could prejudice the competitive position of that person in relation to their business" or (c) it contains "...information whose disclosure could prejudice the conduct or outcome of contractual or other negotiations of the person to whom the information relates". Having considered the contents of several of the records I have decided, on the above grounds, to refuse to grant their release (e.g. records B2.1, B3.1, etc.) or to only partially release them (the relevant information having been redacted) (e.g. records B1, B5, etc.). There are also some records I have not copied as they are already publically available (I have listed website addresses for where these are available, e.g. records A13.1, G15.1, etc.).

2. *I am also seeking photocopies of any corresponding letters, emails, faxes, memos etc between your offices and Dublin Bus regarding extending the bus route 17a and 29a between 1 January 2012 and to date in 2012.*

Schedule E contains a list of the records relating to the route 29a aspect of your request. In relation to route 17a, I have been unable to find any such records and hence, under Section 10(1)(a) (see extracts from FOI Acts attached below) of the FOI Acts, that aspect of your request is refused.

4. Rights of appeal

You may appeal this decision. In the event that you need to make such an appeal, you can do so by writing to:

Your correspondence should include a fee of €75 for processing the appeal. Payment should be made by way of bank draft, money order, postal order or personal cheque made payable to the National Transport Authority. You should make your appeal within 4 weeks from the date of this notification. However, the making of a late appeal may be permitted in appropriate circumstances. *A week is defined in the Act to mean 5 consecutive weekdays, excluding Saturdays and public holidays (Sundays are also excluded, as they are not weekdays).* The appeal will involve a complete reconsideration of the matter by a more senior member of the staff of this Authority.

Relevant Sections from the Freedom of Information Acts 1997 and 2003

Section 10. (1) A head to whom a request under *section 7* is made may refuse to grant the request if _

- (a) the record concerned does not exist or cannot be found after all reasonable steps to ascertain its whereabouts have been taken,
- (b) the request does not comply with *section 7 (1) (b)*,
- (c) in the opinion of the head, granting the request would, by reason of the number or nature of the records concerned or the nature of the information concerned, require the retrieval and examination of such number of records or an examination of such kind of the records concerned as to cause a substantial and unreasonable interference with or disruption of the other work of the public body concerned,
- (d) publication of the record is required by law and is intended to be effected not later than 12 weeks after the receipt of the request by the head,
- (e) the request is, in the opinion of the head, frivolous or vexatious, or forms part of a pattern of manifestly unreasonable requests from the same requester or from different requesters who, in the opinion of the head, appear to have made the requests acting in concert or
- (f) a fee or deposit payable under *section 47* in respect of the request concerned or in respect of a previous request by the same requester has not been paid.

(2) A head shall not refuse, pursuant to *paragraph (b) or (c) of subsection (1)*, to grant a request under *section 7* unless he or she has assisted, or offered to assist, the requester concerned in an endeavor so to amend the request that it no longer falls within that paragraph.

Section 27. (1) Subject to *subsection (2)*, a head shall refuse to grant a request under *section 7* if the record concerned contains _

- (a) trade secrets of a person other than the requester concerned,
- (b) financial, commercial, scientific or technical or other information whose disclosure could reasonably be expected to result in a material financial loss or gain to the person to whom the information relates, or could prejudice the competitive position of that person in the conduct of his or her profession or business or otherwise in his or her occupation, or
- (c) information whose disclosure could prejudice the conduct or outcome of contractual or other negotiations of the person to whom the information relates.

(2) A head shall grant a request under *section 7* to which *subsection (1)* relates if _

- (a) the person to whom the record concerned relates consents, in writing or in such other form as may be determined, to access to the record being granted to the requester concerned,
- (b) information of the same kind as that contained in the record in respect of persons generally or a class of persons that is, having regard to all the circumstances, of significant size, is available to the general public,
- (c) the record relates only to the requester,
- (d) information contained in the record was given to the public body concerned by the person to whom it relates and the person was informed on behalf of the body, before its being so given, that the information belongs to a class of information that would or might be made available to the general public, or

(e) disclosure of the information concerned is necessary in order to avoid a serious and imminent danger to the life or health of an individual or to the environment

but, in a case falling within paragraph (a) or (c), the head shall ensure that, before granting the request, the identity of the requester or, as the case may be, the consent of the person is established to the satisfaction of the head.

(3) Subject to *section 29*, *subsection (1)* does not apply in relation to a case in which, in the opinion of the head concerned, the public interest would, on balance, be better served by granting than by refusing to grant the request under *section 7* concerned.

(4) Where—

(a) a request under *section 7* relates to a record to which *subsection (1)* applies but to which *subsections (2) and (3)* do not apply or would not, if the record existed, apply, and

(b) in the opinion of the head concerned the disclosure of the existence or nonexistence of the record would have an effect specified in *subsection (1)*,

he or she shall refuse to grant the request and shall not disclose to the requester concerned whether or not the record exists.
