Further to your request for information under the Freedom of Information Acts 1997 and 2003 for records pertaining to Enforcement officer's salary scale and qualifications.

Having reviewed your request, I write to advise you that I am refusing to grant your request under Section 7, reference to section 27 1 (c) of the Freedom of Information Act:

***(c) information which disclosure could prejudice the conduct or outcome of contractual or other negotiations of the person to whom the information relates.***

I am further rejecting the request under Section 28(1) because in my opinion access to the records concerned would involve the disclosure of personal information. You may not be aware but the Authority have issued a tender in respect of new compliance support officers, so the release of this information would be prejudicial to the procurement process underway.



The review is a full and new examination of the matter carried out by a more senior member of staff of this body.
