

## **Transferability**

Action 14 of the Taxi Regulation Review Report sets out that taxi licences will no longer be allowed to be transferred or sold to another individual. It had been intended that this would be introduced on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2013 under new regulations to be put in place by the Authority.

However, this measure will now be included in the new Taxi Bill to be published shortly and will become effective when that Bill is passed into law. Accordingly, it is not possible to indicate a definitive date for its introduction as the date will be dependent upon the passage of the new Taxi Bill through the Dáil and the Seanad.
