

Failure to return tamper-proof licence discs

You are obliged to return your tamper-proof licence discs whenever you apply to renew, exchange or change the vehicle on your licence. If you do not return the tamper-proof discs, you will be required to submit documentary evidence that the tamper-proof discs in question have been satisfactorily destroyed e.g. a signed declaration that the tamper-proof discs were destroyed by you personally.

If no documentary evidence can be provided, you must contact the National Transport Authority and request a TP2 form.
