### 2. NTA Update

The NTA update was previously circulated to the members. Wendy Thompson informed the Committee that their advices on Roof Signs has been forwarded to the Department of Transport and will be put before the NTA Board in February. Roisin Cullinan informed the Committee that a record 850 Driver Skills Tests were completed in August 2023 with a significant increase in the number of <40's taking the test. It was agreed that NTA would give a short presentation on electric vehicles and their availability at the October meeting. Wendy Thompson informed the Committee that NTA will be running a driver check app campaign over the coming months and will give a presentation on this to the February meeting.

# 5. Data Capture / Technology

The Chair welcomed Steve Laidler Technical Director Digitax to the meeting to give a presentation on data capture. Some of the queries raised by the Committee were in relation to supply and demand tracking, anonymized smart meter data and automatic vehicle location and how to use data to identify unmet demand.
