

Clamping Signage





To meet the regulatory requirements, clamping signs are required to be.....



- Constructed to a good standard of workmanship;
- Made of good quality, durable, weather resistant materials suitable for the location where the sign is, or is intended to be, located;
- Provide sufficient colour contrast between the text and its background to ensure legibility;
- Maintained complete, in good condition and free from any significant blemish; and
- Maintained clean such that the text and information is visible at all times.





The following examples show some typical locations and how these types of location might look with compliant clamping signage.



Signage Placement



• Location:

 Where a sign is located from a <u>plan</u> point of view, e.g. at vehicular entrance, specific area within a clamping place


• Position:

How high is the bottom edge of the sign above the adjacent ground?

• Orientation:

 The angle the sign is physically set at, e.g. on a wall facing directly out, on a signpost angled towards an entrance

> Flat face = direction sign is facing, i.e. orientation



Signage Locations




Vehicular entrances:

 Located at <u>all vehicular entrances</u> to a clamping place, providing key information to motorists relating to parking and clamping activities upon their entry to the area

• Pedestrian exits:

 Located at pedestrian exit points from either a single-storey car park accessible to members of the public, or a multi-storey car park, to provide sufficient notification and information to persons in relation to clamping activities




• Additional sign locations:

 Provided within a clamping place to provide sufficient notification and information to motorists and persons in relation to clamping activities


Example 1 - Surface Car Park With Different Parking Restrictions






Example 1 with compliant clamping signs






Example 2 - Surface Car Park Adjoining NTA **Another Clamping Place**


