



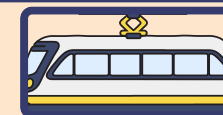
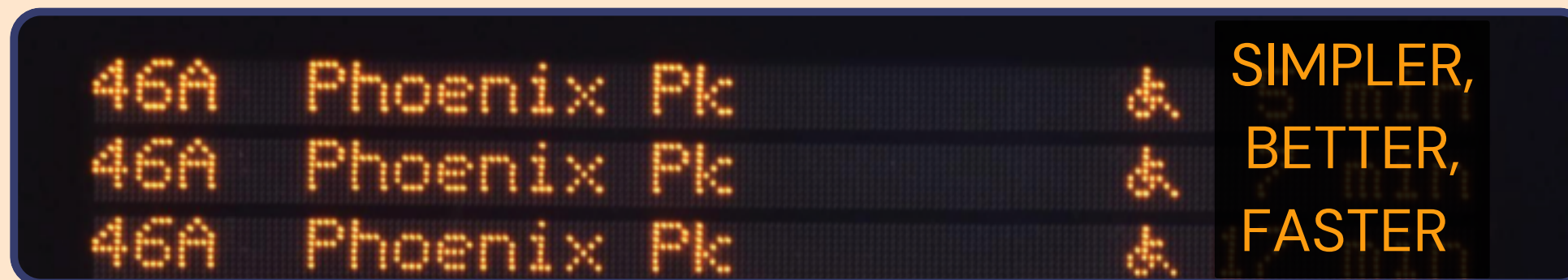
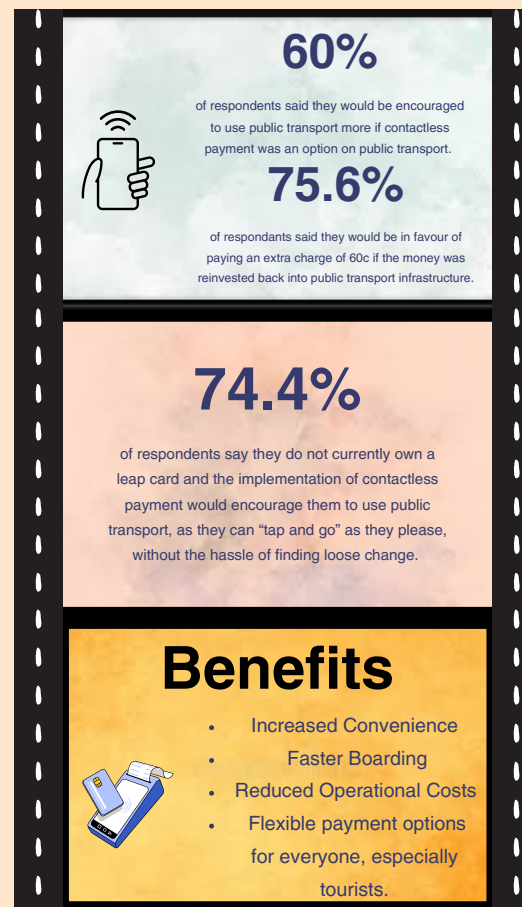
TAP, PAY, RIDE, GO

Background Information

- In Dublin it is currently impossible to pay with contactless payment on all public transport (Dublin Bus, Dart and Luas).
- Tap Tag will give people the option to pay for public transport in Ireland using debit cards, Apple/Google Pay or smartwatches.
- There will be an additional fare of 60c to be charged to use contactless payment, in order to still incentivise the use of the leap card, while still providing an alternative.
- This extra charge will be reinvested into improving public transport infrastructure in ways such as electric buses, or additional digital timetables.
