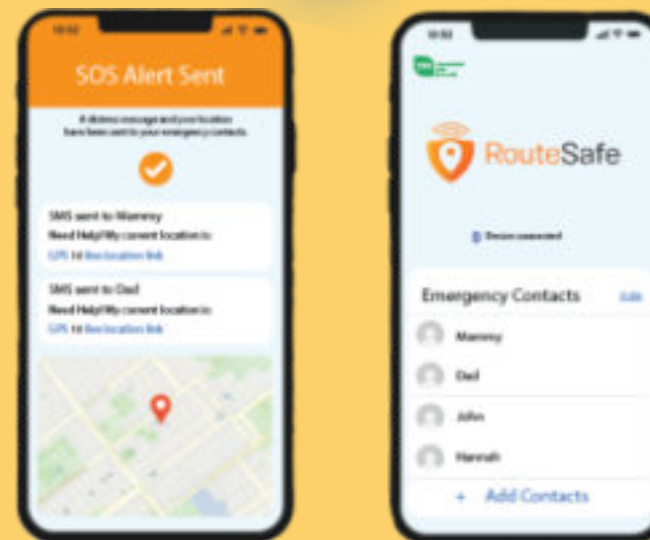


Integrated Safety Light improving personal visibility and act as a deterrent in poorly lit areas.

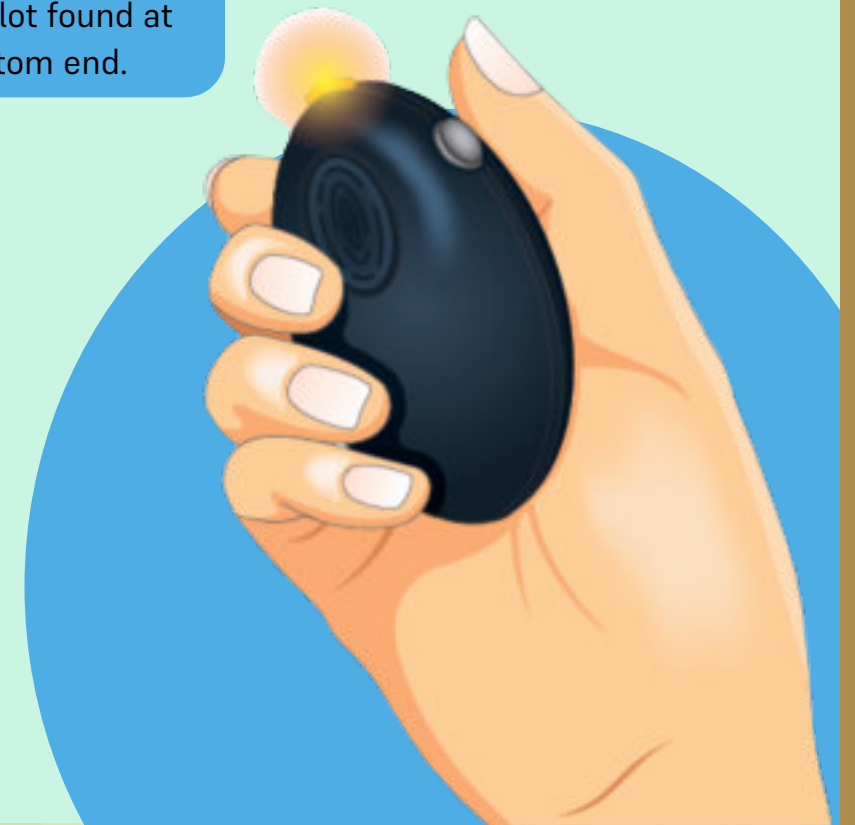
Instant One-Press Emergency Alert in moments of need, a single, intuitive press sends an immediate distress signal to trusted contacts, removing the need to fumble with a phone.
