providing contracted public transport
services**

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1. Introduction

1.1 Overview of contracted public transport

The National Transport Authority (NTA) has statutory responsibility for securing the provision of public transport services as outlined in the Dublin Transport Authority Act 2008. This Act also gives the NTA responsibility for setting public transport fares on Public Service Obligation (PSO) subsidised services and is usually actioned via a Fares Determination.

Public transport usage in Ireland has continued to grow in recent years. In 2025, there was a combined patronage of 363.6 million passenger journeys on subsidised public transport services, representing a 5.8% increase on 2024. To put this strong 2025 performance in context, passenger journeys on public transport services has fully recovered from pandemic era impacts and exceeded the 2019 pre-pandemic peak passenger journey figure of 294.6 million by 23% or 69 million passenger journeys. There are several factors which have led to this success, including elements such as:

- The expansion of public transport services through Dublin Bus Connects;
- The Connecting Ireland rural mobility plan;
- New rail stations such as Woodbrook which opened in August 2025;
- The launch of the new Portlaoise town bus service;
- The implementation of the Dublin commuter zone and associated fare adjustments in April 2025;
- The introduction and subsequent expansion of the TFI 90-Minute Fare (TFI 90) to include commuter rail services in the Dublin Commuter Zone;
- The introduction of the 50% discount for Young Adult (YAC) / Student on equivalent adult leap fares, and the 20% cost of living reduction applied to all PSO fares in 2022.

In 2025, fare free travel was further extended to children age 5 – 8 as well as enabling a companion to travel for free with persons aged 70 and over who are eligible for free travel. These measures contribute to public transport usage and future trip making habits.

1.2 Context of the 2026 Fares Determination

Since 2022, the cost of operating public transport services has increased, the fare levels have decreased, and public policy has extended free travel to new cohorts of passenger narrowing the fare revenue base.

The shift in economic landscape following the COVID pandemic led to a sharp increase in price inflation of 20.8% between January 2022 and May 2026 in Ireland¹. This price inflation also extends to the cost of operating subsidised public transport services such as the cost for purchase / maintenance of vehicles, fuel and staff costs. The post pandemic increase in patronage requires additional vehicles which incurs additional staff costs to drive and maintain the fleet, which puts further pressure on the PSO public transport budget.

In the same time period as the 20.8% price inflation, public transport fares decreased through various measures including the 20% cost of living discount which was applied to all subsidised public transport fares and the Young Adult / Student discount of 50% on equivalent adult leap fares applied in 2022. In 2025, free travel was extended to include children under 9 and for companions of those over 70 as part of the Free Travel Scheme.

Budget 2026 places an obligation that the subsidy for funding public transport will be sustainable i.e. establishing a robust, evidence informed funding framework using a review of the PSO together with the continued implementation by the NTA of the National Fares Strategy² to develop a sustainable funding model for PSO services into the future³. Fare revenue is a vital funding component for public transport alongside the PSO subsidy, the Free Travel Grant and ancillary income channels such as advertising and car parking.

There is a requirement to strike the right balance in public transport fares to enable further enhancements to the public transport network in the coming years, offer the most competitive fares to younger / student passengers and ensure value for money of the PSO subsidy to society.

This Fares Determination will implement a general average increase of 15% across most fare types with some fares increasing by a higher / lower rate. It begins the eventual merging of the fares in Dublin City to a single 90-minute flat fare. This provides a number of benefits including simplification of the fare structure, supporting the future implementation of Next Generation Ticketing and improving boarding times by reducing the need to interact with the driver. As a result, the existing 'Short' fare in Dublin City will be phased out over future Fare Determinations.

This is the first general increase in public transport fares in eight years and is required to address the significant 20.8% price inflation experienced since 2022 in Ireland. Ireland currently has significantly cheaper fare levels than many other comparable UK and European cities and is an outlier in terms of public transport cost recovery from fare revenue. The fare changes will facilitate the continued enhancement and expansion of the public transport network in Ireland, providing viable sustainable transport options for more people and positively contributing to our climate action goals.

Children, Young Adults and Students will continue to benefit from the most competitive fares encouraging public transport usage and embedding future travel habits. The 50% Young Adult / Student leap fare discount will be retained. A reduced child rate priced at 33% of the equivalent adult fare will be standardised in the Dublin Commuter Zone and extended to services in the regional cities and towns. It is the NTA's intention to standardise these discounts across the full PSO public transport network in a future determination.

In summary, this Fares Determination will introduce the following changes:

Dublin City Zone: Bus Services operated by Dublin Bus and Go-Ahead Ireland, Luas light rail services and DART heavy rail services operated by Iarnród Éireann Irish Rail.

- Cash / Leap fares and products to increase by an average of 15%
- Short fare to increase by 33% to €2

Dublin Commuter Zone: Bus services operated by Bus Éireann, Go-Ahead Ireland, J.J. Kavanagh & Sons, and commuter rail services operated by Iarnród Éireann.

- Most fares and current products to increase by an average of 15%
- A new reduced child rate priced at 33% of the equivalent adult fare for all ticket types
- Retention of interim fare measures introduced as part of the Dublin Commuter Zone rollout

Regional City: Bus services in Cork, Galway, Limerick, and Waterford.

- No change to the Cork City Bus Leap, Cash and Daily / Weekly cap rates
- A new flat fare replacing the standard and higher zone fares in Galway, Limerick and Waterford
- Adult Leap fare to increase by 10% to €1.70, with a 15% increase in period products
- Standardisation of the 50% Young Adult discount across all ticket types in the regional cities
- A new reduced child rate priced at 33% of the equivalent adult fare

Town: Athlone, Balbriggan, Carlow, Clonmel, Drogheda, Dundalk, Kilkenny, Mullingar, Navan, Portlaoise and Sligo

- Town fares to increase by 10% for Leap Adult to €1.65 and 15% for Cash to €2.30
- Student / Young Adult fares and products to be priced at 50% of the equivalent adult fare
- A new reduced child rate priced at 33% of the equivalent adult fare of €0.50 cent Leap / €0.80 cent cash

National: Bus Éireann stage carriage and Intercity rail services operated by Iarnród Éireann Irish Rail.

- Bus stage carriage fares and products to increase by an average of 15%
- Intercity rail Open Return tickets to be discontinued (see Section 4.3 for further details)
- Intercity rail Express fares to increase by 10% and Economy fares by up to 20%
- Review of rail promotional fares

TFI Local Link: Regular Rural Services

- An average 15% increase in single fares
- Retention of the 50% Student / Young Adult discount and child fares priced at 33% of the equivalent adult fare
- Standardisation of period product rates in line with fare policy

These revised fares are planned to take effect during 2027 following consultation with operators on implementation timelines. A full list of fare types and rates are provided in the Appendices to this document.

2. Dublin city and commuter zone

2.1 Introduction

The Dublin city and commuter Zone went live from April 2025 as illustrated in Figure 2.1. It comprises of city bus services operated by Dublin Bus, Go-Ahead Ireland, Luas light rail services and DART heavy rail services in the Dublin city zone, and bus services operated by Bus Éireann, Go-Ahead Ireland, J.J. Kavanagh & Sons Route 139 and commuter rail services operated by Iarnród Éireann Irish Rail in the commuter zone.

A key feature of the new zonal structure is the implementation of crow fly distance-based fares in line with the National Fares Strategy 2023. In addition, the multimodal cap was reduced, and TFI 90 was extended to include passengers on commuter rail services from zones two, three and four, greatly expanding the number of origins and destinations available on a single public transport fare.



Figure 2.1 Dublin City and Commuter Zones

This Fares Determination proposes an increase in most fare types by an average of 15% (33% for the city zone short fare), the retention of the interim period products which were introduced as part of the Dublin city and commuter zone rollout, and a standardisation of the child single fare to 33% of the equivalent adult rate resulting in a discount for child passengers.

2.2 Dublin city zone

Dublin city zone fares apply to Dublin city bus (Dublin Bus, Go-Ahead Ireland ODMA & Go Ahead W4 / W6), Luas light rail and DART heavy rail services.

Travel within the Dublin city zone has been significantly enhanced in recent years. From a fares perspective the introduction of TFI 90 and the enablement of daily / weekly multimodal caps has opened up more trip types for a greater number of origins and destinations via public transport. The increased passenger journey figures in 2025 for Dublin Bus, Luas and Go-Ahead Ireland services is evidence of the benefit of an integrated multimodal network catering to the needs of passengers.

It is the NTA's intention to merge the 'Short' and TFI 90 fare in Dublin city to create a single flat 90-minute fare. This will support the introduction of Next Generation Ticketing and contactless EMV⁴ payments, simplify the fare offering and facilitate reduced boarding times. This Fares Determination will begin this process and increase the short fare in Dublin city by 33% (Dublin City Bus, Luas and Rail) for adult Leap to €2.00, Cash €2.70 and Young Adult Leap to €1.00.

The TFI 90 offering is retained, and the fare will be increased by 15% for all passenger types i.e. Adult (€2.30), Young Adult (€1.15) and Child (€0.75). TFI 90 is a key integrated fare product and delivers a significant passenger value through transfer flexibility. The revised TFI 90 adult rate of €2.30 is either cheaper than, or broadly in-line with, many other European cities. For example, Amsterdam⁵ currently charges €3.40 for 60-minute free transfer whilst Milan⁶ charges €2.20 for a 90-minute offering.

Most other fares in the Dublin city zone will increase by an average of 15%, however as a result of the standardisation of child fares to 33% of the equivalent adult rate there will be some fare reductions, for example the child Xpresso / Nitelink child fare will reduce by 10% for leap to €0.90.

2.3 Dublin City Zone Caps

An equivalent 15% increase in the Dublin city zone multi-modal leap daily and weekly caps is required to compliment the increase in general fare levels. For example, the Adult daily cap will increase from €6 to €6.90 and weekly from €24 to €27.60. Capping will continue to provide excellent value for passengers making multiple multimodal trips and compares favourably to zonal caps in other cities such as Amsterdam

which has a daily multimodal cap (or ticket) of €10 / weekly €43⁷, Milan which has a daily rate at €7.60⁸ and Paris which has a daily ticket of €12.30 / weekly €32.40⁹.

2.4 Dublin Commuter Zone

Dublin commuter zone fares apply to commuter bus services operated by Bus Éireann, Go-Ahead Ireland, commuter rail services operated by Iarnród Éireann and J.J. Kavanagh & Sons route 139¹⁰. The 2024 Fares Determination created a new Dublin commuter zone, comprised of zones two, three and four illustrated in Figure 2.1. These zones extend from the edge of the Dublin city zone to about 50km from Dublin city centre and include settlements such as Dunshaughlin, Kilcock, Clane (Zone Two), Drogheda, Trim, Enfield, Newbridge, Wicklow (Zone Three) and Navan, Kildare and Rathdrum (Zone Four). Fares within the commuter zone were aligned with distance-based pricing and the NTA's National Fare Strategy. Daily, Weekly, Monthly and Annual products were made available, and the TFI 90 fare was introduced for passengers using commuter rail to Dublin facilitating onward travel within 90 minutes in the city zone. Interim fares were applied to some zone two and zone three period products in recognition of the migration to the new structure.

As part of this Determination, fares in the Dublin commuter zone will generally increase by an average of 15%. For example, rail passengers travelling from Newbridge to Dublin O'Connell Street will pay a revised Leap fare of €6.90 adult and €3.45 young adult. This includes TFI 90 for onward travel between Dublin Heuston and O'Connell Street on Luas or Dublin city bus services.

The interim fares introduced in the 2024 Fares Determination, which applied a discount to some zone two and three weekly fares as part of the migration to the new zonal structure will be retained in this determination with an average 15% increase. It is the NTA's intention to adjust these interim fares to match standard zone two and three weekly prices in a future Fares Determination.

The third main change delivers on a commitment set by the NTA in the 2025 Fares Determination to price all child fares at 33% of the adult equivalent leap and cash rate in the Dublin commuter zone. This fare reduction equates to an average discount of approximately 23% to 27% for child passengers. For example, a child travelling between Laytown and Balbriggan will pay a revised rail fare of €0.85 Leap Single which is a 26% decrease from the current €1.15 rate. In addition to the extension of fare free travel for children up to their ninth birthday, this ensures children in the Dublin commuter zone will pay the lowest fare and offers excellent value for money for child passengers and their families.

2.5 Eastern regional zone

Bus Éireann continue to offer zonal products for longer distance commuter travel from areas such as Cavan, Virginia, Mullingar, Tullamore etc.¹¹ As part of this Determination, the fares which apply in these Yellow and

Orange Outer Zones will increase by 15% for adult Leap one day, seven day, monthly and annual products and continue to provide good value for regular longer distance commuters.

This Determination will also standardise the discount ratios that apply on these products whereby a young adult / student is 50%, and child 33% of the equivalent adult fare. This results in significant reductions in fare levels for younger passengers. A child Yellow Zone 1-day product will reduce by 34% from €9.60 to €6.35, and by 25% from €33.60 to €25.35 for a 7-day product. Similarly, the young adult / student Yellow Zone 1-day product will reduce by 26%, while the 7-day Yellow and Orange Zone products will reduce by 16%. These reductions in fare levels ensure excellent value for money for children, young adults and students and will hopefully encourage increased public transport usage.

3. Regional Cities & Towns

3.1 Introduction

Regional city bus services operate in Cork, Galway, Limerick and Waterford with dedicated town bus services in operation in Athlone, Balbriggan, Carlow, Clonmel, Drogheda, Dundalk, Kilkenny, Mullingar, Navan, Portlaoise and Sligo.

Fare reform in our urban centres is ongoing and will contribute to a network effect of public transport in our regional cities and towns. TFI 90 and associated daily / weekly caps was rolled out in Cork City in July this year¹², and as such no change is proposed to the Cork City fares in order to support the implementation and attractiveness of the new fare structure. A flat city fare, which is a prerequisite for the implementation of a 90-minute ticket, will be introduced in Galway, Limerick and Waterford.

Town Fares will increase by 10% on adult leap rates to €1.65 in this Determination, while young adult/student and child discounts will be standardised across all ticket types to 50% of equivalent adult and 33% respectively, in both towns and regional cities. This will result in a 23% fare reduction for child leap, encouraging public transport usage, particularly in areas serving centres of education.

3.2 Regional Cities

Cork

The 2025 Fares Determination¹² rationalised the Cork City bus fare to a flat fare for travel with the adult Leap single set at €1.70, Young Adult €0.85 and Child €0.55. These rates will be retained for this Fares Determination as will the current cash single fares of adult €2.40 and child €0.80. A further Fares Determination in early 2026 established a city bus only Leap daily and weekly cap¹³. This was successfully implemented in July 2026 along with TFI 90 and will provide excellent value for the current 5,000 regular travellers and new passengers who will benefit from free onward bus to bus travel on the Cork city bus network. Capping will extend to the Cork commuter rail network in a subsequent Fares Determination subject to technical capability.

Cork commuter rail fares for cash, leap and period products will increase by an average of 15% for adults. The standardisation of discount ratios with young adult / student priced at 50% and child at 33% of equivalent adult fares, will see a decrease for most child fare types. This Determination will split out the current child leap single flat fare rate of €0.65, to equivalent bands A to D in line with the Adult fare structure and a distance-based fare principle. As a result, Band A rates decrease by 15% to €0.55 while Band D rates to / from Mallow and Cork City increase to €1.50. This €1.50 rate still provides excellent value for over 30km of travel when compared to Dublin and other cities internationally. Child cash single, day return and monthly fares will all decrease from current rates in the order of 20-26%. This fare reduction will ensure younger people and students continue to pay the lowest available fare for their trip needs in Cork City.

It is the NTA's intention to develop a new Cork commuter zone and associated fares for both bus and rail in a subsequent Fares Determination. This is in line with the National Fare Strategy 2023 and will follow similar

principles to the Dublin city and commuter zones to ensure equity and consistency in terms of public transport fares across the country.

Galway, Limerick, Waterford

This Determination will discontinue the standard zone fare for the regional cities and implement a flat urban fare identical to Cork City of Leap Adult €1.70, Young Adult €0.85 and Child €0.55. This represents a 10% increase for Adult passengers currently paying the higher zone fare, and a 26% increase for those paying the €1.35 standard zone fare. The implementation of standard discount rates for younger passengers will lead to a 15% reduction in a leap single fare for children from €0.65 to €0.55. The introduction of this flat city fare is a pre-requisite for the implementation of a 90-minute product. As outlined above, this 90-minute fare is being implemented in Cork this year, and it is the NTA's intention to rollout a similar 90-minute offering in the other regional cities in future Determinations to support the BusConnects network redesign programme.

All Regional Cities – Period Products

1-day, 7-day, Monthly and Annual period tickets are available in all the regional cities allowing unlimited travel on the city bus networks. This Determination will increase the adult price for these tickets by an average of 15%, whilst also introducing the standard discounts for Young Adult / Students at 50% and Child at 33% of equivalent adult fares. This results in significant fare reductions in the range of 18%-37% for younger passengers travelling regularly in the regional cities. For example, a student one day product will be reduced by up to 31% and up to 37% for a child. This fare reduction will ensure younger people and students continue to pay the lowest available fare for their trip needs.

3.3 Town Services

Town services operate in Athlone, Balbriggan, Carlow, Clonmel, Drogheda, Dundalk, Kilkenny, Mullingar, Navan, Portlaoise and Sligo. The NTA continues to invest in new and enhanced town services with new services launched in Portlaoise in 2025 and Mullingar in February 2026, as well as an enhancement to the Sligo town service with new route S3 commencing service in 2025. In recent years the NTA has also ensured that TFI Local Link services which serve an urban area with a relatively good cumulative level of frequency, should also use a town fare where appropriate. This rule has been applied on local link routes in 13 towns¹⁴ and ensures internal urban travel in these towns is offered at the lowest possible fare.

This Fares Determination will increase the adult leap town fare by 10% to €1.65 Leap and cash town fare by 15% to €2.30, which will support the continued expansion of the town bus networks. The standardisation of a child fare discounted to 33% of the equivalent adult fare sees a reduction of 23% in the child leap fare to €0.50, with the young adult fare set at €0.80 (approximately 50% of the equivalent Adult fare).

4. National Bus & Intercity Rail Services

4.1 Introduction

Nationwide interurban and regional subsidised public transport services are operated by Bus Éireann and Iarnród Éireann Irish Rail and are a key part of the interurban public transport network and ensure availability of public transport for work, education, social and other trip needs across the island of Ireland.

4.2 Bus Éireann

Currently Bus Éireann interurban routes are based on a stage carriage basis, with Leap or cash accepted on all Bus Éireann services within the Republic of Ireland. Leap availability ensures that adults can avail of fares up to 30% cheaper than cash singles while young adults and students get discounted fares 50% cheaper than the equivalent adult fare. This Fares Determination proposes to increase all Bus Éireann Stage Carriage fares for both cash and leap by an average of 15%. A subsequent Fares Determination addressing the rollout of the National Fares Strategy will review the standardisation of child fare discounts similar to that implemented in the Dublin Commuter Zone, regional cities / towns and TFI Local Link.

4.3 Intercity Rail - Singles, Returns & Web Fares

The focus of recent Fare Determinations on intercity fares was on smoothing the boundary between Intercity and commuter zone fares around Dublin. Whilst this disparity was eliminated in the 2024 Fares Determination, it is accepted that long standing anomalies remain on parts of the wider intercity network, for example fares are priced according to journey type, route travelled or location in Ireland.

Historically, Intercity rail fares have been priced based on the quality and frequency of service, and are divided into three categories: Express, Economy 1 and Economy 2. The rationale for price differentials on these different services is no longer as relevant, and to support the future rollout of the National Fare Strategy, the NTA have been merging these categories over time. For example, in previous Determinations, the Economy 1 and Economy 2 fares have been merged together to form a single 'Economy' rate. This Determination will continue that work and reduce the variance between Express and Economy fare levels by increasing the Express fare by an average of 10% and the Economy fares in the range of 8%-21%.

For this Fares Determination, Open Return fares will be discontinued as part of ongoing rail fare reforms to support the implementation of Next Generation Ticketing and contactless payment due to limitations in the reading of outdated magnetic stripe tickets. Passengers are encouraged to avail of web fares which continue to offer excellent value for single and return journeys, particularly when booked in advance. This also helps support the prediction of train loadings and best use of available rail capacity on the intercity network.

Iarnród Éireann Irish Rail provide a number of promotional fares across the network and were introduced at a time to stimulate rail demand. For example, this includes discounted rates for tourists. To take account of current fare policy developments such as web fares, the extension of free travel to new cohorts, and the establishment of the Dublin Commuter Zone, the NTA will undertake an evidence-based review of these fares with the operator to continue / discontinue promotional rates which best support rail service funding.

4.4 National Fares Strategy

It is acknowledged that the current method of setting stage carriage bus and Intercity rail fares can result in a fare disparity along parts of the network. It is the NTA's intention to rollout the National Fares Strategy across the stage carriage bus and intercity rail network with planned implementation currently scheduled for 2027. This will enable the migration to consistent and equitable crow fly distance-based fares as well as the standardisation of discount ratios for young adult / student and child passengers in-line with the Dublin Commuter Zone.

5. TFI Local Link

TFI Local Link include both scheduled fixed route regular rural and door-to-door services, and patronage has grown rapidly in recent years. This can be attributed to the rollout of the Connecting Ireland Rural Mobility Plan which increased transport connectivity for people living in rural Ireland. TFI Local Link are at the forefront of innovation in PSO public transport services. At present TFI Local Link Mayo, Limerick and Kerry are piloting a Smart Demand Responsive Transit (DRT) service called TFI Anseo in Achill, Killarney and north-east Limerick City¹⁵. Smart DRT differs from regular public transport services as it serves a demand-based coverage area rather than a fixed route service. In addition, contactless payment options are currently being rolled out across the Local Link network with full deployment currently scheduled for the end of 2026¹⁶. This ensures passengers can pay by Leap, Cash or Contactless for their trips.

TFI Local Link fares remain relatively low compared with the cost of providing the service and have been traditionally lower than other PSO public transport operations. The table below shows a sample of adult leap fares between Local Link and Bus Éireann. Certain parts of the public transport network are served by both Bus Éireann which calculates fares on a stage carriage basis, and by TFI Local Link which charges fares on a per 10km basis. For historic reasons the variance between adult leap fares can be considerable. These variances are acknowledged at a network level in the National Fares Strategy.

There is an obligation to ensure PSO funding is better supported by TFI Local Link fares in the short and longer term. In the longer term, TFI Local Link fares will be reviewed as part of the rollout of the National Fares Strategy across the state along with Bus Éireann stage carriage and Iarnród Éireann Irish Rail fares. In the short term, this Fares Determination will increase Local Link fares by an average of 15% and implement a standardised multiplier to calculate a one-day product at 2.5 single trips and a seven-day product at 3.5-day rates. This is in line with how period products are priced in the Dublin Commuter Zone and provide excellent value for regular travellers.

No fare adjustments are proposed to TFI Anseo services as they are still pilot routes.
