WALKING 

How long would it take to walk or cycle to UCC?

Check out the time bands to see how long it would take you to walk or cycle to and from campus. Don't forget to use the cycle planner to find the best route for you

Walking paths on campus are well signed, well-lit and secure. There also is a Slí na Sláinte route close to the campus. The Student Hub building will accommodate a better walk through route in the east-west directions for a pedestrian thoroughfare.



CYCLING 

There are covered and uncovered cycle racks throughout the campuses. Cycle racks are mostly monitored by CCTV. However cyclists are strongly encouraged to ensure that they lock their bicycle appropriately with a strong lock. See the map for the locations of the bike parking.



There is a bicycle maintenance offered to staff and students four times a year.

The Cycle to Work scheme is available to all staff at UCC. You can use a salary sacrifice arrangement to **save up to 51%** of the retail price of bike and equipment.





Currently there is one pump available. There is a cycling club present on campus. There are 24 fleet bikes – available for staff and postgraduates only.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT   

The closest train station is at **Cork Kent Station** is three kilometres from the campus. There are hourly intercity services to and from Dublin Heuston Station which take between 2.5 and 3 hours. There are also frequent commuter services to/from Mallow, Midleton and Cobh.

Cork Bus Station is located at Parnell Place in the city centre. The bus station is served by all Bus Éireann local and intercity services. To get to UCC, city buses route 205 ('CIT/Rossa Avenue') and 208 ('Bishopstown') from the bus station or at nearby St Patrick Street (outside Debenhams) will take you here. The bus stop number for UCC (College Road) is 241741.



Local and Express services towards the West (e.g. Ballincollig, Macroom, Bandon, West Cork) stop on request on Western Road / Gaol Cross.

Coaches: There are express coach services to Dublin and Dublin Airport (operated by Aircoach and GoBe) and to Limerick/ Galway (operated by CityLink).

For staff members it's also possible to get **Tax Saver** tickets. The cost is deducted directly from the employee's gross salary, and **savings of between 28.5% and 52%** can be made off the regular price, depending on ticket type and your tax band.

LEAP CARD 

TFI Leap Card is a convenient way to pay for public transport services in Dublin, Cork, Galway, Limerick, Waterford, Sligo, Athlone and Wexford.

It saves you carrying change and **TFI Leap Card fares are up to 31% cheaper than cash single tickets!**

Using your TFI Leap Card is easy. Simply buy your card, Top-Up with Travel Credit or a period ticket and away you go!



You can buy the Student Leap card on campus at the student union.

FACILITIES

There are several active commuting facilities available on campus.

There are several lockers available.

There also is a drying room in the Tindall building.

For staff there are shower facilities around the campus in different buildings - 4 in Cane Building, 4 in Western Gateway and 4 in science building.

Students can use the gym facilities which have shower and changing units.

TRANSPORT FOR IRELAND (TFI) APPS 

 **The TFI Journey Planner App from Transport for Ireland** is the only journey planner that provides timetable and map information from all licenced public transport providers across Ireland. It is the only app that allows you to plan and start your journey from your doorstep.


 **TFI Leap Top-up App is a free app for NFC (near-field communication)** enabled Android phones. It allows you to instantly top-up your TFI Leap Card, check your balance, collect and buy tickets and check how close you are to reaching your daily and weekly cap values.

 **The TFI Real Time Ireland App** is the only app that integrates all real time information services from Dublin Bus, Bus Éireann, Go-Ahead Ireland, DART, Iarnród Éireann and Luas services. The app provides live updates, helping you plan your journey efficiently on the TFI public transport network.

 **The TFI Driver Check App** is a service that allows users to check that the vehicle they are about to hire has been registered correctly and that the driver has the appropriate license to operate the vehicle. If the information appears incorrect, it is possible to submit a report.

 **The TFI Cycle Planner App** provides information on the best cycling routes for trips in the Dublin, Cork, Galway, Limerick and Waterford city areas.

If you are new to cycling or getting out on the bike after a long break, the TFI Cycle Planner will find a route that avoids roads with heavy traffic and also avoids difficult turns at busy junctions to help you get comfortable cycling your bike around town and beyond.

CAR SHARING & DRIVING

There is a car club on campus called GoCar.

GoCar allows you to rent cars for as little as half an hour, using a booking system to reserve the vehicle and in-car technology to unlock the car and drive.

There is one base opposite the entrance to University College Cork, at the corner of College Road and College View.

For car-poolers there are specific spaces for car-poolers who register with UCC.

For electric vehicles there are charge points at the electrical engineering building and at the research institute.

TAXI  

If you decide to travel by taxi you can use the free Taxi Driver Check app to verify your taxi and email it to a friend. There is one taxi drop off location located off the main entrance from College Road.

Taxis can also be booked in advance - see transportforireland.ie for licenced dispatch operators.


